


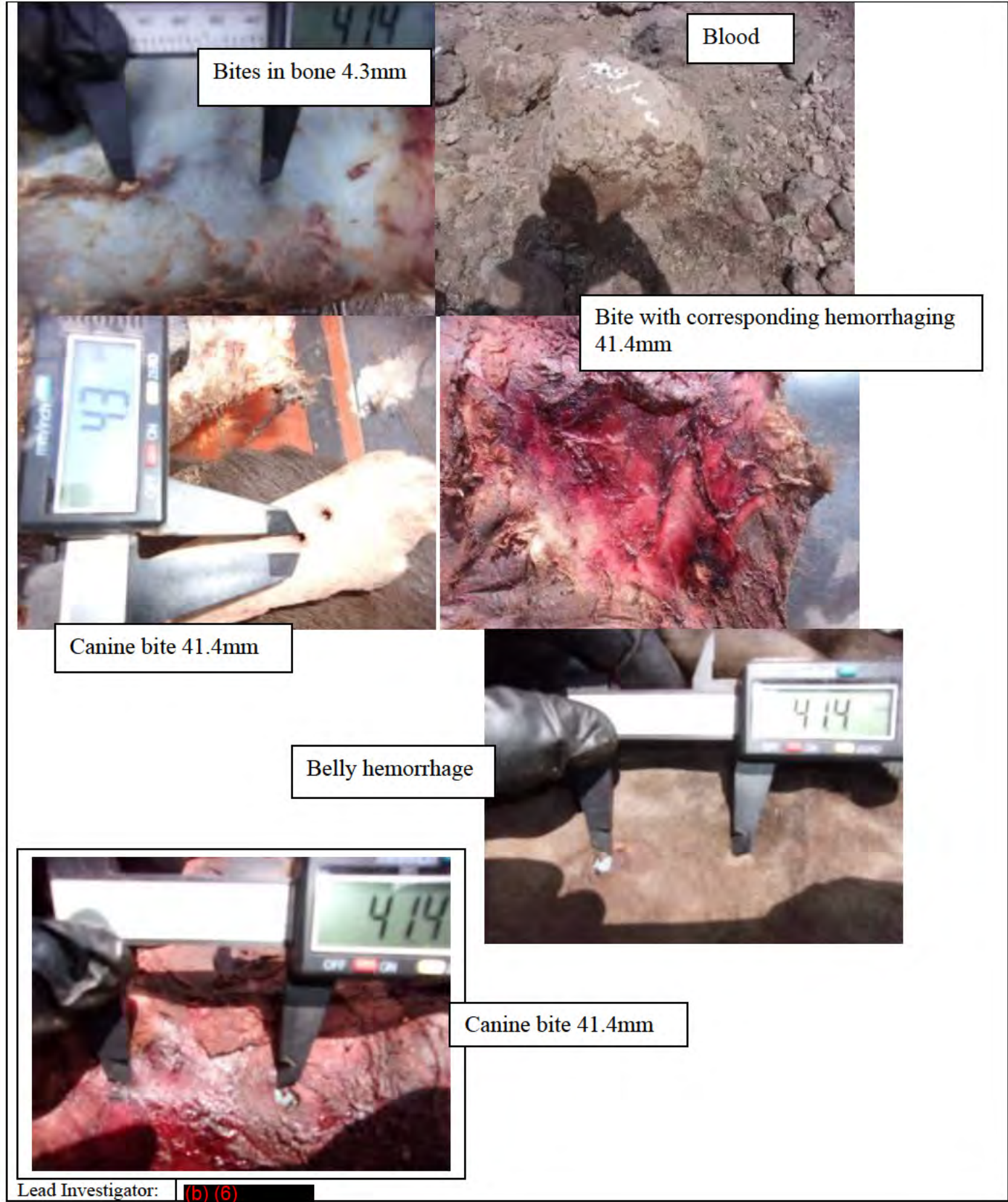

SUMMARY OF INCIDENT			
<p>Wildlife services was contacted by (b) (6) on 5-31-2020, reporting that a rancher found 2 dead calves and requested an investigation. We arrived at the ranch on 6-1-2020 to do the investigations. The rancher reported collared wolves from the Lava Pack in the area. The rancher informed us that one carcass had disappeared overnight, so the investigation was done on the remaining carcass. Upon arrival we found a large area of disturbed ground around the carcass and on the hill. We found hair, blood and wolf tracks coming down the hill and around the carcass. We clipped and skinned the calf finding 2 compression bites of 41.4mm on the left side. We found a 41.4mm bite on the belly with corresponding hemorrhaging. There was massive hemorrhaging in the belly area. There were broken bones with large diameter canine depressions. With the evidence found at the scene and knowledge of wolves denning in the area I determined that this calf was killed by Mexican gray wolf.</p>
